

- 100% by the end of 2028


FCC Enhanced A-CAM:

Year 3

40% of deployments are to be completed.

At the end of 2024 for carriers authorized in 2021 and at the end of 2025 for carriers authorized in 2022 or later.


Year 4

60% of deployments are to be completed by the end of Year 4.

Oklahoma has 86,729 locations receiving \$73.64M in subsidy support.




Oklahoma's OBO ARPA SLFRF Program

OBO's Broadband Upcoming Funding Programs




BEAD \$764.4 Million

OBO released BEAD Initial Proposal Volume II for public comment on October 27th, comment period closes on November 26th.




OBO's BEAD Process Timeline: \$764.4M

Subgrantee Process Timeline






BEAD \$45B State Allocations



Highlights of BEAD Program Requirements

- Eligible areas are areas that lack 100/20 connections to wireline or licensed wireless will be eligible. Projects will have to be scalable to 100/100 and higher.
- 2. Labor standards (prevailing wage, workforce plan, and utilizing skilled trades) are a part of scoring and reporting post award.
- 3. Enhanced Network Resiliency, Cybersecurity
- 4. Addressing Climate Impact
- 5. Environmental and Historic reviews required
- 6. BABA Requirements Watch for Waivers
- 7. NEW! Waiver for Letter of Credit
